## **ERASMUS Intensive Programme in Helsinki in spring 2013**

### **ICHCI 3 – IPPSE Interdisciplinary Programme on Poverty and Social Exclusion**

The interdisciplinary programme on poverty and social exclusion is a programme aimed at developing skills and competences in understanding, recognizing and preventing poverty and social exclusion. The IP applies multicultural, multidisciplinary, multi professional and multi actor approaches in the implementation of the programme. This intensive programme is meant for all the students in the field of health care and social services with a basic knowledge and a multidisciplinary and international interest.

The main activities are: pre-assignment in the home country and a ten-day intensive programme in Helsinki with multi professional student and teacher groups. The IP consists of field work, keynote lectures, group work, tutorial discussions, student presentations and assignments.

This IP is 3 ECTS + Preparatory assignment 1 ECTS. In total 4 ECTS.
